(Returning the Angel Tag will insure your gift goes to the correct child.) Monetary donations are also welcome to help us implement and complete this worthwhile mission project. Checks should be made payable to HOPE and deposited in the HOPE box in the church office.*

By choosing an angel at dinner on Wednesday, November 14 and at the 8:45am and 11:00am worship services on Sunday, November 18, you will remind a child in Wake County that they are not forgotten by their incarcerated parent. They will also know there is a God who loves them and will not forget them either.
