
Cultivate Community Challenge

Antiracist Reading Groups

As we continue our commitment to fighting racism in ourselves and our community, we are forming antiracist reading groups. In order to be effective allies and participants in the movement for racial justice we must educate ourselves on our history, on white supremacy, and on the most effective ways to eliminate it. We strongly encourage all members interested in continued action against racism to join a group. The groups will begin the first week of July, and we will work through an incredible list of books and excerpts for the next year. The first book we will read is Me and White Supremacy by Layla Saad (A note to our congregants of color: This book is particularly written for white and white passing people, as a guide to interrogating white privilege and white supremacy within themselves. You are welcome to read it as well but we felt it necessary to begin with some

Backpack Buddies Update

Due to the ongoing hunger crisis resulting from the pandemic, the Backpack Buddies program will not be going on hiatus this summer. Update from the Stewardship Committee

In the midst of the pandemic, there is something simple that we can all do for the church that will make a huge difference – set up online giving. Every Sunday that we are not at church, we experience a decline in giving. Even though we are not physically together, the church still has to pay its bills, our wonderful staff, and make sure that our church is prepared to help the most vulnerable among us especially during this pandemic.

There are three ways to tithe online:

- 1. Set up an automatic payment through your bank using the "Bill Pay" function. This will result in your bank mailing a check to the church on a weekly or monthly basis.
- 2. Give online through the church website. Simply go to <u>gfbccary.org/give</u> to access the online giving module.
- 3. Set up an automated bank draft by filling out the form attached to the bulletin, attaching a voided check, and mailing it to the church office at Greenwood Forest Baptist Church, 110 SE Maynard Road, Cary, NC 27511.

Together, we can make sure that Greenwood Forest can continue to serve our community for years to come!
