When my feeble life is o'er, Time for me will be no more; Guide me gently, safely o'er To thy kingdom shore, to thy shore.



Way to Give at GFBC

In the midst of the pandemic, there is something simple that we can all do for the church that will make a huge difference — set up online giving. Ways to tithe:

- 1. Set up an automatic payment through your bank using the "Bill Pay" function. This will result in your bank mailing a check to the church on a weekly or monthly basis.
- 2. Give online through the church website. Simply go to <u>gfbccary.org/give</u> to access the online giving module.
- 3. Set up an automated bank draft by filling out the form attached to the bulletin, attaching a voided check, and mailing it to the church office at Greenwood Forest Baptist Church, 110 SE Maynard Road, Cary, NC 27511.
