
Ways to Give

In the midst of the pandemic, there is something simple that we can all do for the church that will make a huge difference—set up online giving. Even though we are not physically together, the church still has to pay its bills, our wonderful staff, and make sure that our church is prepared to help the most vulnerable among us especially during this pandemic.

Ways to tithe:

- 1. Set up an automatic payment through your bank using the "Bill Pay" function. This will result in your bank mailing a check to the church on a weekly or monthly basis.
- 2. Give online through the church website. Simply go to gfbccary.org/give to access the online giving module.
- 3. Set up an automated bank draft by filling out the form on the next page of this bulletin, attaching a voided check, and mailing it to the church office at Greenwood Forest Baptist Church, 110 SE Maynard Road, Cary, NC 27511.
