Keep our anger from becoming meanness. Keep our sorrow from collapsing into selfpity. Keep our hearts soft enough to keep breaking.


Keep our outrage turned towards justice, not cruelty. Remind us that all of this, every bit of it, is for love.



ONE Wake Update from Internal Assembly

On February 25, ONE Wake held an internal assembly (a gathering of members) to discuss our strategy for 2021. It includes:

- Working with county commissioners on setting aside publicly-owned lands for affordable housing, an ongoing effort
- Finishing the listening campaign related to the needs of educators, children, and parents as a result of the pandemic
- Mobilizing a robust turnout for upcoming municipal elections, which are typically extremely low turnout elections
- Training more members of our institutions in community organizing.

ONE Wake will be hosting a special training series called IAF University that's free of charge for all ONE Wake member institutions. **Attendees will learn how to build power through relationships, be better leaders at their churches, and how to mobilize people for action**.

Spots will initially be offered to current members of the ONE Wake Core Team at GFBC, but if you would like to attend this leadership development training (which can be helpful at work as well as at church!), contact Rev. Spears-Newsome (<u>wesley.spears-newsome@gfbccary.org</u>). The commitment is three two-hour sessions spread out over three months with multiple date/times for each session.



In the midst of the pandemic, there is something simple that we can all do for the church that will make a huge difference: set up online giving. Every Sunday that we are not at church, we experience a decline in giving. Even though we are not physically together, the church still has to pay its bills, our wonderful staff, and make sure that our church is prepared to help the most vulnerable—especially during this pandemic.
