We affirm each prayer with the following response:


Leader: Lord, in your mercy.



Return to Church Plan



As COVID-19 numbers improve in North Carolina and many of our congregants get vaccinated, we are excited to begin planning for a safe return to in-person congregational activities. We have erred on the safe side during the pandemic, and will continue to be cautious; however, based on the available science, and the safeguards we will keep in place, we are confident that some in-person operations can be resumed safely in the coming weeks. We, of course, will reverse

course if the situation changes, so plans are subject to alterations.

For the first two months of our Return to Church plan, worship will be the only churchwide in-person activity on campus. This is to ensure that we are limiting the amount of contact as we get our feet wet while still prioritizing our most important gathering as a community.

For the month of April, we will meet each week for worship outside on the lawn (if weather prevents an outside gathering, we will cancel in-person worship and move to live-stream only for that week). Worship on the lawn will have the same COVID-19 precautions as it did when we held a service in the fall (masking, distancing, stay home if you have had symptoms, bring your own chair if you are able).

Assuming that the COVID-19 numbers are not worsening after those four weeks of outdoor worship, we will hold in-person worship in the Sanctuary beginning on May 2. These indoor worship gatherings will be modified and have precautions in place to ensure everyone's safety.
