

A Penny For Housing

One of the founding issues member institutions of ONE Wake selected to address was housing. ONE Wake is currently addressing housing in different campaigns among the municipalities in Wake County. The Cary campaign is called **A Penny For Housing**. The Town of Cary has plans for creating and preserving affordable housing, but it has invested few local resources to implement them. Meanwhile, everyone from teachers, healthcare workers, first responders, to be prepared to develop lesson plans or prepare for Sunday mornings. Contact Rev. Dr. Stacks if you're interested!
