Today's colors are white and gold. White and gold for the Easter season symbolize divine light, the joy of resurrection, and the glory of God.





Candidate Assembly on April 28

You are invited to a candidate assembly with those running for Town Council in Cary on April 28 at 6pm, the first day of early voting. The event is hosted by Greenwood Forest Baptist Church and our ONE Wake member churches in Cary and we strongly encourage you to attend. After hearing from the candidates, there will be an optional march to the polls to cast our ballots.

The event will be at First United Methodist Church in Downtown Cary and voting will take place at the Herb Young Community Center a few blocks away. Register to attend at gfbccary.org/vote.

Regardless of whether you can attend the candidate assembly, we want to make sure everyone in our congregation who lives in Cary votes in our municipal elections. You can pledge to vote at the display in the narthex by adding your name.

Early voting begins on April 28.

Election Day is May 17.
