### GFBC Gets Out the Vote!

Two of the Cary Town Council seats up for election this year have advanced to a runoff—meaning the top 2 voter getters from the earlier election will be up for a vote again. We were able to score a major victory in securing \$9 million in funding for housing in Cary this year, but to keep those gains we need a council that supports housing and will listen to citizens concerned about it.

You have multiple opportunities to get out the vote:

### Canvass with GFBC and ONE Wake

You can go talk to voters and distribute election information on July 16 (10am, Jack Smith Park) or July 25 (10am at GFBC). Sign up at <u>onewake.org/events</u> to let us know you're coming!

### Pledge to Vote

You can also pledge to vote yourself by adding to the narthex display your name and the names of anyone in your household/friends who you pledge to get to the polls.
