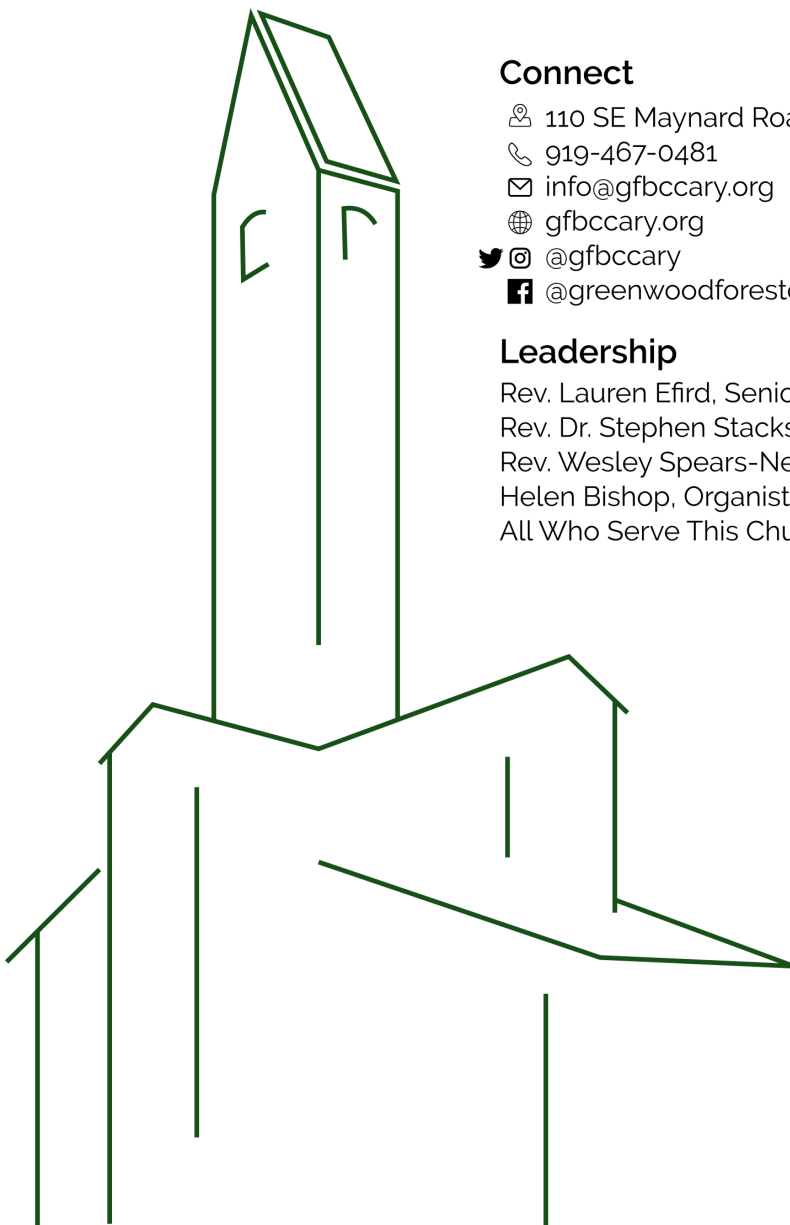
† **Hymn 134 (vv. 1 and 4)** | *Silent Night, Holy Night*
