
*The Baptism of Jesus* by Castera Bazile (Mural)

The bulletin cover this week is the mural of the baptism of Jesus in Cathedrale de Sainte Trinite (Holy Trinity Cathedral) in Port au Prince, Haiti. The artist, Castera Bazile was a Haitian painter born in 1923. Bazile was self-taught and is considered one of the most famous Haitain master artists. He is responsible for three murals in the same cathedral with the subjects of the Ascension of Christ, the Baptist of Christ, and Christ Expelling the Money Changers from the Temple. The murals were mostly destroyed in the 2010 Haitian earthquake.

In this image, we see John (in red and yellow) baptizing Jesus in a river with waterfalls in the background. Others go about their daily work while the event is happening and the Holy Spirit (in the form of a dove, as in the Gospels) sits perched on a tree. Both the scene and the figures resemble a mix of biblical imagery and images of daily life in Haiti.

Consider how this momentous event happens in the midst of daily life. Do the others even know the magnitude of the event that is taking place? The understatement of the event contrasts sharly with other depictions. What can it teach us? Consider: What could be happening in the midst of your life that you're missing? Where is God calling things "beloved" in your community and daily life?

### Coffeehouse Theology

Gerard Manley Hopkins wrote, "The world is charged with the grandeur of God." In this series, we'll test the hypothesis that every thing is sacred by looking at "secular" music and how it speaks to our spiritual lives. Each week, Rev. #### The Passing of the Peace

The passing of the peace is a symbolic enactment of the reconciling love and mercy of God in our midst. We express it through a peace sign, a handshake, a wave, or many other expressions of peace. Be mindful and considerate of others' desire for physical space or distance.

#### Prayer in Worship

We use many kinds of prayers in worship. The Call to Worship is a communal prayer using call and response. The Invocation is a single individual inviting (or invoking) God into our worship this morning. The Prayers of the People uses intercessory prayer to ask God to come to the world's aid. The benediction is a blessing offered over those gathered in worship.

A "doxology" is a short hymn that usually praises the Trinity. We sing the doxology as we symbolically present our offerings back to God.


#### The Prayers of the People


This prayer typically has five parts: a confession, prayers for the earth, prayers for the world, prayers for the church, and prayers for those with needs in our own community.
