### Welcome




**Bulletin Art:** "Judith" by Jean-Joseph Benjamin-Constant (d. 1902), a French painter and etcher.



### Rev. Dr. Stacks' Sabbatical

This Sunday is Rev. Dr. Stacks' last Sunday before his sabbatical! Thank Stephen for all that he does and wish him the best on this time of rest and renewal! Dr. Abe Cáceres will begin joining us next week in worship.

### Summer Program Underway

The Neighborhood Summer Program happens every summer for local kids. The program offers food (breakfast and lunch) and summer enrichment activities for children of all ages. You can bring your child to the Kirk of Kildaire Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from June 20 to August 17 from 9am to 1pm. ### Help Stop LGBTQ Discrimination in NC

During the last legislative session, three bills targeting transgender and other LGBTQ people passed the NC General Assembly: a ban on trans athletes in women's sports (HB574), a "Don't Say Gay" bill banning certain instruction and forcibly outing kids to families (SB49), and a ban on genderaffirming care for minors (HB808).

All three bills were vetoed by the governor but the General Assembly can override the veto. If you'd like to help prevent those bills from overcoming the veto, write or call (or better yet, go visit!) your state senator and state representative (regardless of party) and urge them to vote against these bills.

The veto-proof majority is very slim and it only takes a minor defection to defeat any of these bills.

### The Passing of the Peace

The passing of the peace is a symbolic enactment of the reconciling love and mercy of God in our midst. We express it through a peace sign, a handshake, a wave, or many other expressions of peace. Be mindful and considerate of others' desire for physical space or distance.

### **Prayer in Worship**

We use many kinds of prayers in worship. The Call to Worship is a communal prayer using call and response. The Invocation is a single individual inviting (or invoking) God into our worship this morning. The Prayers of the People uses intercessory prayer to ask God to come to the world's aid. The benediction is a blessing offered over those gathered in worship.


